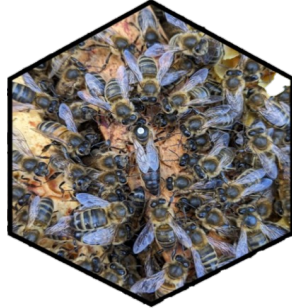

HONEY SHOW RULES

1. Staging of the exhibits will be carried out exclusively by Stagers or Stewards.
2. Only Stagers, Stewards or other designated Honey Show Officials are allowed in the staging area before and during staging and judging. All other persons are excluded until judging has been completed and the results announced.
3. Exhibits may not be touched except by a Stager, Steward or Judge, until they are returned to the owner after results have been announced.
4. All honey and wax exhibits must be the product of the exhibitor's own bees. Other exhibits must be the work of his or her own hand.
5. FBKA labels will be affixed by a Honey Show official to each entry, in order to identify it. No other identification mark is permitted.
6. All classes are open to all beekeepers.
7. Entry fees will be £1.00 per exhibit
8. Exhibitors may make more than one entry in one class, but only one placement will be awarded to such an exhibitor in that class.
9. No single exhibit may be shown in more than one class.
10. For the Vaughan Trust Perpetual Trophy aggregate points will be awarded as follows:
1st place 4 points 2nd place 3 points
3rd place 2 points 4th place 1 point.
11. The judge, whose decision is final, may:
 - Withhold awards should the standard not be judged sufficiently high
 - Submit any exhibit for analysis
 - Disqualify any entry without giving a reason
12. Cups and trophies will be held for one year only.

CLASS RULES

1. The beeswax exhibit (H8) must be plain, cast block of any shape, but of 340 gm (12oz) minimum weight and a maximum thickness of 1 inch at its thickest point.
2. Extracted honey must be exhibited in clear glass 454 gm 1lb jars, either BS Squat or Irish Tall, with matching screw or twist-off lids.
3. BSI 1656 Honey Grading Glasses will be used for run honey classes.
4. Cut comb honey must be shown in clear plastic 228gm (8oz) cases with transparent snap-on lids. Gross weight per piece must be not less than 200gm
5. Deep or shallow frames of honey may be shown in clear-sided protective cases or on a stand with both sides of the comb clearly visible.
6. Sections may be square or round, and exhibited in clear film with both sides of the comb fully visible.
7. Chunk honey should contain 50% comb.
8. In classes where more than one item is required (e.g. 6 jars extracted. 2 cut comb) all individual items, both contents and containers must match.
9. H10 Must be made by Exhibitor with explanatory notes
10. Any Artistic/Craft Exhibit on a "BEE" related Theme must be Exhibitors own work.
11. Novice Class for anyone who has not previously won a prize.
